

# **PROHIBITED AND RESTRICTED ITEMS AND ACTIONS**

**THIS LIST MAY NOT BE ALL INCLUSIVE  
AND ANY OTHER ACTIONS MAY BE  
DEEMED PROHIBITED OR RESTRICTED  
AT THE TIME OF OCCURRENCE, AS  
DETERMINED BY B2022 VENUE STAFF  
OR POLICE, RESPECTIVELY.**

## PERMITTED

- Toiletries and medicines in aerosol, liquid, cream and gel form for personal use, in commercial containers of 100ml or smaller. Glass containers are not permitted. Larger containers allowed if medically prescribed in commercial containers.
- One full/filled, sealed or resealable plastic or metal beverage container, or sealed paper carton, not exceeding 1 litre in volume. Glass containers are prohibited.

## RESTRICTED

- Certified assistance dogs only.
- One bag, up to 25 litre capacity, soft sided bag per person. Not to exceed 50cm high, 30cm wide, 20cm deep.
- One additional bag of same size and construction for families with infants or persons with a disability.
- Prams, baby carriers, wheelchairs, and other mobility aids are permitted when required.
- Controlled drugs or items having the appearance of controlled drugs. Only when medically prescribed in quantity for individual personal use, commercially packaged, and labelled with contents.
- Flammable substances, liquids and fuel ie. cigarette lighters, matches, and size compliant personal use toiletries.

## **RESTRICTED**

- Reasonable quantities of baby food, milk, and pre-mixed formula allowed where a baby or infant is present.
- Flammable substances, liquids and fuel ie. cigarette lighters, matches, and size compliant personal use toiletries.
- Reasonable quantities of baby food, milk, and pre-mixed formula allowed where a baby or infant is present.
- Hazardous substances including powders, pastes, chemicals, irritants, toxic and flammable substances, as required for legitimate medical purposes.
- Mobile phones, single external mobile phone power source, personal use cameras or lenses of no more than 30cm length.

## **PROHIBITED**

- Any item that is illegal to carry or possess under UK law.
